Does my pony have to be registered with the BCPS to compete in the Scheme?

Yes.

Can overheight ponies compete in the Scheme?

I understand that the Scheme year runs from 1st October to 30th September. If I join the Scheme in, say, April, can I count points for placings already gained since 1st October?

Yes, provided:

1. the competitions were affiliated to or organised by one of the organisations listed on page 5 of the rules, AND
2. you can get the card signed by the relevant show secretaries or provide printouts of results published on the internet, or the animal's competition record from the relevant governing body.
