AFFILIATIONS AND QUALIFIERS

NATIONAL PONY SOCIETY (S5.160) Qualifiers for 2019 Summer Championship Show.

NPS Mountain and Moorland Qualifying Rounds Breed Show Rules: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective M&M studbooks. Part bred are not eligible for M&M classes. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members. **The owner of a pony qualifying at a breed show must become an NPS Qualifying/Life Member in order to compete at the Final at the Summer Championship Show 6th-8th August Three Counties Showground, Malvern 2019.** The highest placed pony in each eligible class will qualify for the final. Qualification will pass no lower than 3rd place. **NPS Silver Medal Rosettes** can be awarded to ponies at breed shows even if their owners are

not NPS members but to enter the final they must become **NPS Qualifying /Life Members**.

BRITISH SHOW PONY SOCIETY (B.S.P.S.40.19)

This show is a qualifier for **The B.S.P.S LeMieux Heritage Mountain & Moorland Semi-Final** to be held at **The B.S.P.S. Heritage Championship Show** at **Arena UK** on **October 12th-13th 2019**. Ponies, Owners and Riders must be B.S.P.S. Members before the date of the Championship Show to compete at the **Semi Final**. To be judged under B.S.P.S. rules as per the 2019 B.S.P.S. THE TAM O'SHANTER IN-HAND CHAMPIONSHIP

This show is a qualifier for the Tam O'Shanter In-Hand Championship to be held at the **BCPS Annual Breed Show 2020**. The 3 highest placed ponies in Classes 3, 5 and 6 not already qualified will qualify for the finals qualification to go no lower than 6th place.

ROSMEEN RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP This show is a qualifier for the Rosmeen Ridden Championship to be held at the **BCPS Ridden Show 2020**. The highest placed 138 pony in class 12 not already qualified (qualification to pass no lower than 3rd place) and the Pure Bred Ridden Champion if not already qualified will qualify. If the Champion has already qualified then qualification will pass to the Reserve Champion. Exhibitors do not need to be members of the BCPS to qualify for this Championship but will have to pay non member entry fee in order to compete at the final.

NPS DRESSAGE CHAMPIONSHIPS

This show is a qualifier for the **NPS / Supreme Dressage Championship Finals 2020** to be held at **Addington Manor Equestrian Centre 5th April 2020**. The two highest placed ponies from each section in class 21 and class 22 will qualify and will be eligible to represent their breed, NPS Area or other Team in the 2020 Team Challenge at the Final. The Final will be run under NPS Dressage Rules 2019/2020.

EQUIFEST- this show is affiliated to **Equifest 2019**, taking place at the **East of England Showground** on the **29th Aug -1st September 2019**. The **two** highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the relevant **Equifest Championships** - M&M in Hand, Intermediate Ridden M&M and Ridden Part Breds.

TSR REGIONAL FINALS.

This show is a qualifier **2019 TSR SHOWING** Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, North East, North West, East Anglia, South, South East, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals.

TSR Riders Finals 1st & 2nd riders qualify and receive a qualification card in the ring.

TSR In Hand Finals – The two highest placed Handlers with an TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand Class. Handlers **MUST** have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available free from the TSR website. Full details at the www.theshowingregister.co.uk.

TSR Medal Awards – TSR members can collect Q cards & signatures and redeem for a TSR Medal see TSR website for details.

BHSA Grass Roots Championship – With a TSR Qualification Flyer you can enter the BHSA Grass Roots Champs on the 9th September at Addington Equestrian

BRITISH CONNEMARA PONY SOCIETY

RULES FOR SHOWING

1. No Connemara Pony may be shown after the age of six months unless it is registered in a recognised Connemara Pony Stud Book.

2. No Foal may be shown under the age of four weeks
.

3. No entire male may be shown or take part in any competition restricted to Connemara or Registered Mountain and Moorland Ponies after the 1st June in the year in which he attains the age of three years unless he has been registered as a Stallion in the BCPS Stud Book or the Stud Book of a recognised Connemara

Pony Society. Stallions registered after 1st March 2007 must be registered in Class 1 or Class 2.

4. No female or gelding may be shown or take part in any competition restricted to Connemara or Registered Mountain and Moorland Ponies after 1st January in the year in which it attains the age of four years unless it has been registered as an adult pony in the BCPS Stud Book or the Stud Book of a recognised Connemara Pony Society. Mares and Geldings registered after the 1st March 2007 must be registered in Class 1 or Class 2, with the exception of Geldings registered as adults in BCPS Stud Book in 2007 and 2008.

5. Unless entered in a class specifically for Over-height Connemara's no Purebred Connemara Pony exceeding 148cms in height may be shown or take part in any competition restricted to Connemara or Registered Mountain and Moorland Ponies within the jurisdiction of the BCPS.

6. Where it is reported to the BCPS that this may have occurred, the society may require the animal to be measured or re-measured in accordance with the rules of the Joint Measurement Board Ltd. The penalty for contravening the above rule may be cancellation of the registration of the animal concerned.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW

RULES AND REGULATIONS

This show is affiliated to the National Pony Society. NPS rules for showing will apply to all classes that are not qualifiers for the British Show Pony Society.

Riders and handlers of stallions must have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January of the current year. All Riders whilst mounted must wear correctly secured current British Standard skull caps/riding hats. Hard Hats are recommended for all Handlers.

All ponies must be registered by the closing date of entries in the appropriate section of the BCPS Stud Book or Register, in the Stud Book of an Approved Connemara Society or in the Part-Bred Register where applicable.

A copy of the BCPS Showing Rules is available from the BCPS Secretary or on the BCPS web site: www.britishconnemaras.co.uk ENTRIES ARE ACCEPTED ON THE ASSUMPTION THAT EXHIBITORS HAVE READ THESE RULES .It is the responsibility of Exhibitors to enter ponies correctly in the appropriate class.

Neither the organisers of this event nor the BCPS nor any agent or representative thereof accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness or any loss of any kind whether financial or otherwise suffered by any horse, pony, owner, rider, spectator, land, building, person, animal or any other property of any type whether caused by negligence, breach of contract, breach of trust, or in any way whatsoever.

It is a condition of entry that all exhibitors shall, to the extent allowed by law, indemnify this Show and Osbaldeston Riding Centre and its Officials, Servants and Assistants against all actions, proceeding, claims or otherwise in relation to or arising from his/her entries in this show, and each entry form MUST be signed as

having accepted these conditions. **FORMS NOT SIGNED WILL BE RETURNED.**

The Committee reserves the right to cancel, amalgamate or divide classes as and when necessary. The Judges decision is final. We strongly recommend the wearing of body protectors for younger competitors.

Open to pure bred registered M&M stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over.

A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1st January in the current year, it has done any of the following:

- i. Won an open affiliated mixed M&M Ridden class
- ii. Qualified for Horse of the Year Show, Olympia or RIHS Open M&M Ridden classes
- iii. Qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate Ridden final at the NPS Summer Championship show (N.B. Ponies can compete as novices in this

competition for two consecutive years provided they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year).

iv. If a pony qualifies for Horse of the Year Show, Olympia or RIHS in its second year it is immediately de-noviced and cannot compete in the Picton Final. Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit.

Method of judging: each pony will enter the ring individually and jump a course designed to produce a maximum 10 jumping efforts each jumping effort will be marked out of 5. Five penalties will be awarded for a pole down or run out. Three refusals at any one fence will result in elimination. Fall of pony or rider will result in elimination. A maximum of 50 marks will be awarded there is no conformation mark but a mark of 10 will be awarded for overall impression at the end of the round .In the event of a tie the overall impression mark will decide the final placing.
