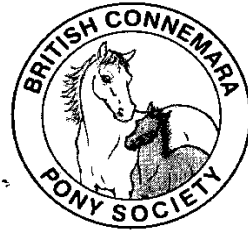

AFFILIATIONS AND QUALIFIERS

NATIONAL PONY SOCIETY

Qualifiers for 2018 Summer Championship Show.

NPS Mountain and Moorland Qualifying Rounds Breed Show Rules:

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland studbooks. Part bred are not eligible for M&M classes.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members and at breed shows ponies can qualify for finals even if their owners are not members. Owners of qualified ponies must become adult Qualifying or Life members to enter the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from **31st July -2nd August 2018.**

The highest placed pony, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

Silver Medal Rosettes can be awarded to ponies at breed shows even if their owners are not NPS members but to enter the final they must become **NPS Qualifying Members.**

THE TAM O'SHANTER IN-HAND CHAMPIONSHIP This show is a qualifier for the Tam O'Shanter In-Hand Championship to be held at the **Annual BCPS Breed Show on Saturday 14th July 2018 at Vale View Equestrian Centre, Nottingham Lane, Old Dalby, Melton Mowbray LE14 3LX.**

The 3 highest placed ponies in Classes 11, 12, 13 and the 3 highest placed two and three year olds in Class 14 not already qualified will qualify for the finals - qualification to go no lower than 6th place. The three highest placed Connemara Mares in class 9 will qualify for the Tam O'Shanter Breeding Championship.

ROSMEEN RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP This show is a qualifier for the Rosmeen Ridden Championship to be held at the **BCPS Show 2018.** The highest placed 138 pony in class 20 not already qualified (qualification to pass no lower than 3rd place) and the Pure Bred Ridden Champion if not already qualified will qualify. If the Champion has already qualified then qualification will pass to the Reserve Champion. Exhibitors do not need to be members of the BCPS to qualify for this Championship.

BCPS YOUNG HANDLER

The Young Handler Championship to be held at the **BCPS Show 2018.** The owners of ponies must be members to enter the final. Handlers will be judged on Handler Turnout, Pony Presentation and Showing Technique at the Final. The two highest placed competitors 12yrs and under and two highest placed competitors 13yrs -17yrs will qualify. It is open to both pure and part-bred ponies/horses. **No Stallions or Colts must be shown in these classes.**

BRITISH CONNEMARA PONY SOCIETY RULES FOR SHOWING

- 1.** No Connemara Pony may be shown after the age of six months unless it is registered in a recognised Connemara Pony Stud Book.
 - 2.** No Foal may be shown under the age of five weeks.
 - 3.** No entire male may be shown or take part in any competition restricted to Connemara or Registered Mountain and Moorland Ponies after the 1st January in the year in which he attains the age of three years unless he has been registered as a Stallion in the BCPS Stud Book or the Stud Book of a recognised Connemara Pony Society. Stallions registered after 1st March 2007 must be registered in Class 1 or Class 2.
 - 4.** No female or Gelding may be shown or take part in any competition restricted to Connemara or Registered Mountain and Moorland Ponies after 1st January in the year in which it attains the age of four years unless it has been registered as an adult pony in the BCPS Stud Book or the Stud Book of a recognised Connemara Pony Society. Mares and Geldings registered after the 1st March 2007 must be registered in Class 1 or Class 2, with the exception of Geldings registered as adults in BCPS Stud Book in 2007 and 2008.
 - 5.** Unless entered in a class specifically for Over-height Connemara's no Purebred Connemara Pony exceeding 148cms in height may be shown or take part in any competition restricted to Connemara or Registered Mountain and Moorland Ponies within the jurisdiction of the BCPS.
 - 6.** Where it is reported to the BCPS that this may have occurred, the society may require the animal to be measured or re-measured in accordance with the rules of the Joint Measurement Board Ltd. The penalty for contravening the above rule may be cancellation of the registration of the animal concerned.

NPS RULES AND REGULATIONS

This show is affiliated to the National Pony Society. NPS rules for showing will apply to all classes that are qualifiers.

Riders and handlers of stallions must have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January of the current year. All Riders and handlers of ponies aged 14 years and under must wear correctly secured current British Standard skull caps/riding hats. Hard Hats are recommended for all Handlers.

All ponies must be registered by the closing date of entries in the appropriate section of the BCPS Stud Book or Register, in the Stud Book of an Approved Connemara Society or in the Part-Bred Register where applicable.

A copy of the BCPS Showing Rules is available from the BCPS Secretary or on the BCPS web site: www.britishconnemaras.co.uk **ENTRIES ARE ACCEPTED ON THE ASSUMPTION THAT EXHIBITORS HAVE READ THESE RULES** .It is the responsibility of Exhibitors to enter ponies correctly in the appropriate class.

Neither the organisers of this event nor the BCPS nor any agent or representative thereof accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness or any loss of any kind whether financial or otherwise suffered by any horse, pony, owner, rider, spectator, land, building, person, animal or any other property of any type whether caused by negligence, breach of contract, breach of trust, or in any way whatsoever.

It is a condition of entry that all exhibitors shall, to the extent allowed by law, indemnify this Show and Todburn Equestrian Centre and its Officials, Servants and Assistants against all actions, proceedings, claims or otherwise in relation to or arising from his/her entries in this show, and each entry form **MUST** be signed as having accepted these conditions. **FORMS NOT SIGNED WILL BE RETURNED.**

The Committee reserves the right to cancel, amalgamate or divide classes as and when necessary. The Judges decision is final.

Any person wishing to lodge a protest with reference to any person or exhibit shall do so in writing within 30 minutes of the termination of the class, and at the same time shall deposit a sum of £50.00. If on investigation by the committee the protest is not sustained the deposit will be forfeited.

Catering will be provided on site.

Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.

WORKING HUNTER CLASSES - Judge: Mrs P Hodge

Class 1 Training Stakes Competition (not affiliated to NPS)

Open to Stallions, Mares and Geldings 4 years old and over.

Open to Over Height, Part Bred and Pure Bred Connemara ponies. Riders may only ride one pony in each class. This class is designed to encourage the pony/rider to perform stylishly.

Section 1 Height of fences 55 cm - 65 cm

Section 2 Height of fences 65 cm - 75cm

If entered in Section 1 the same combination may not enter Section 2.

Method of judging :

Each pony will enter the ring individually and jump a course designed to produce a maximum ten jumping efforts – each jumping effort will be marked out of 5.

5 penalties will be awarded for a pole down or a run out.

Three refusals at any one fence will result in elimination.

Fall of pony or rider will result in elimination.

A maximum number of 50 marks will be awarded. There is no conformation mark. A mark of 10 will be awarded for overall impression at the end of the round. In the event of a tie, the overall impression mark will decide the final placing.

PURE BRED WORKING HUNTER PONY CLASSES - Judge: Mrs P Hodge.

No change of rider or saddlery is allowed between phases or during a phase. A correctly fitting hard/skull cap to current BSI standard must be worn and securely fastened. **Protective front boots only** may be used for the jumping phase and ridden phase. Bandages and protective pads on pony's feet are not allowed.

Class 2 Nursery Novice WHP

Open to pure-bred and part-bred/over height registered Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. **Please note, part-bred and over height competitors are required to wear a white armband.**

For ponies in their first year of competing in WHP classes and who have not won a novice WHP class as at 1st January in the current year. To be shown in a suitable snaffle bridle. Maximum height of fences 61cms.

Class 3 NPS/Area 25 M&M Novice Working Hunter Pony National Championship. (MM-NWHP) Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over. To be judged under NPS rules 2018.

A pony is not eligible to compete if, before the 1st January in the current year, it has done any of the following i) Won an open NPS affiliated class M&M WHP Class, ii) Won a class at a M&M WHP (Horse of the Year Show or RIHS) qualifying round, iii) Qualified For the NPS M&M Novice or Intermediate WHP final at the NPS Summer Championship Show.iv) Qualified for an M&M WHP final at the Horse of the Year Show or RIHS in previous years or in the current year. Riders may only ride one

pony in each section. Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit. **Please state which section on the entry form** (N.B. Ponies can compete as novices for 2 consecutive years provided they do not make an entry in the final in the first year)

Section 2 Ponies exceeding 122cms but not exceeding 133cms

Height of Fences 55cms – 65cms max. 55cms spread.

Section 3 Ponies exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms

Height of Fences 65cms -75cms max. 65cms spread.

Section 4 Ponies exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 148cms.

Height of Fences 75cms -85cms max.75cms spread.

Class 4 NPS/Area 5 Intermediate WHP. Stallion, Mare or Gelding 5 years old and over (MM-IWHP)

Never to have qualified for the NPS M & M WHP (HOYS/RIHS) Final in previous years. Riders may only ride one pony in each section. **Please state which section on the entry form**

A water tray and a change of direction must be included .If a hazard is included; it will be numbered and marked as a fence.

Section 2 Ponies exceeding 122cms but not exceeding 133cms

Height of Fences 60cms – 75cms max. 60cms spread.

Section 3 Ponies exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms

Height of Fences 70cms -85cms max. 70cms spread.

Section 4 Ponies exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 148cms.

Height of Fences 80cms -95cms max. 80cms spread.

Class 5 NPS M&M/TOPSPEC Working Hunter Pony National Championship

Open to registered purebred M&M Stallions, Mares and Geldings 5 years old and over. To be judged under NPS rules 2018. (MM-WHP)

Riders may only ride one pony in each section. The course will consist of a minimum of seven fences one of which must be a spread. A water tray and a change of direction must be included .If a hazard is included; it will be numbered and marked as a fence.

Section 2 Ponies exceeding 122cm but not exceeding133cms.

Fences - 65cms - 80cms max.65cms spread

Section 3 Ponies exceeding 133cm but not exceeding 143cms

Fences - 75cms - 90cms max.75cms spread.

Section 4 Ponies exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 148cms

Fences - 85cms-100cms max.85cms spread.

PURE BRED WORKING HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP

1st and 2nd prize winners from Classes 3-5 to compete.

PART-BRED AND OVER-HEIGHT CLASS.

Class 6 WHP Part-Bred and Over-Height Connemara. Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over.

Maximum height of fences (90cms)

PURE BRED IN HAND CLASSES - Judge: Miss K Wainwright

A rosette will be presented to the highest placed British bred Connemara pony in each of the in-hand pure bred classes. **To be eligible to compete for the rosette the competitor must wear a white armband.**

All winners of these rosettes are eligible to compete in the British Bred Championship which will be held immediately before the overall pure bred championship.

Classes 7 -9, 11-14 are qualifiers for **The NPS/Highbrook Stud Summer In-Hand Championship 2018** see page 2 for details.

Classes 9,11-14 are qualifiers for **The Tam O'Shanter In-Hand Championships**

Class 7 Barren Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over. (MM-IH)
To be run under NPS rules 2018.

Class 8 Stallion, 4 years old and over. (MM-IH)

All entries must be registered in Class 1 or Class 2 of the Stud Book of a recognised Connemara Pony Society

To be run under NPS rules 2018.

Class 9 Brood Mare, 4 years old and over, with foal at foot or certificate of service for the current year. (MM-IH) Certificate of service to be shown to the Show Secretary when collecting numbers.

To be run under NPS rules 2018.

Class 10 Foal of the above mares eligible for entry in the BCPS Stud Book .

1st and 2nd prize winners from Classes 7-9 to compete

Class 11 Yearling Colt, Filly or Gelding (MM-IH)

To be judged under NPS rules 2018.

Class 12 Two Year Old Filly or Gelding (MM-IH)

To be run under NPS rules 2018.

Class 13 Three Year Old Filly or Gelding (MM-IH)

To be run under NPS rules 2018.

Class 14 Two Year Old Colts/Three Year Old Stallion. (MM-IH) Two year old colts. Three year old stallions must be registered in Class 1 or Class 2 of the studbook of a recognised Connemara Pony Society.

To be run under NPS rules 2018.

Champion and Reserve from the Pure Bred Adult In Hand Championship and the Youngstock In Hand Champion and Reserve to compete

The Champion to receive the **NPS/ KILMANNAN STUD M&M In Hand Silver Medal Rosette** and Sponsors Rosette.

A silver medal rosette is offered by the NPS to the Best Pure Bred in Hand pony .If the Champion has already qualified it is still entitled to the rosette but the qualification passes to the reserve, qualification passes no lower that first reserve.

Owners do not need to be NPS members to qualify but must become NPS members to enter the **Silver Medal Championship Final** at the **NPS Summer Championships 2018** foals are not eligible.

PART-BRED AND OVER-HEIGHT CLASS - Judge: Miss K Wainwright

Class 15 NPS/Mole Valley Farmers In hand Part Bred National Championship

Stallion, Mare or Gelding any age. (O-PBIH)

Exhibits must be registered in the part bred section of their society studbook and registration numbers must be stated on the entry form.

Class 16 BCPS Young Handler. Open to competitors aged 18yrs and under please state your age on the entry form. The two highest placed competitors aged 12yrs and under and the two highest placed competitors 13-17 yrs. will qualify for BCPS Show 2018.

RING 2 Commencing at 1.30pm.

PURE BRED RIDDEN CLASSES - Judge: Miss K Wainwright.

Class 17 Nursery Novice Ridden Class.

Open to pure-bred and part-bred/over height registered Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. **Please note, part-bred and over height competitors are required to wear a white armband.**

A pony is deemed a Nursery Novice if it is in the first year of competing in ridden classes and has not won a mountain and moorland novice ridden class by the 1st of January of the current year. Ponies will only require to walk and trot together but may canter in their individual show. Snaffle bits only.

Class 18 The NPS/Picton Stud M&M Novice Ridden National Championship (MM-NR)

Stallion, Mares or Geldings 4 years old and over. To be judged under NPS rules 2018. Snaffle Bits only.

A pony is not eligible to compete if, before the 1st January in the current year it has done any of the following. Won an open NPS affiliated class mixed M&M Ridden class. Won a ridden class at Olympia, Hoys or RIHS qualifying round. Qualified for the Horse of the Year Show or RIHS ridden classes. Qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate Ridden Final at the NPS Summer Championship Show (N.B. ponies can compete as novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year.) Qualified for the M&M Ridden Final at Olympia in previous years. If a pony qualifies for HOYS or RIHS in its second year it is immediately de noviced and cannot enter the Picton Final.

Class 19 The NPS/Peasedown & Jess Talbot M&M Intermediate Ridden National Championship (MM-IR)

Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over.

To be judged under NPS rules 2018.

A pony is not eligible to compete if it has qualified before the 1st January in the current year for the The M&M Ridden Championship Final at Horse of the Year Show, RIHS or Olympia.

Class 20 The NPS/Ringside Stud Open Ridden National Championship (MM-OR).

Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over.

To be judged under NPS rules 2018.

This class is a qualifier for the **Rosmeen Ridden Championship** to be held at the British Connemara Pony Society Show 2018. See page 2 for details.

PURE BRED RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP

1st and 2nd prize winners from Classes 17 -20 to compete

This championship is a qualifier for the Rosmeen Ridden Championship to be held at the British Connemara Pony Society Ridden Show 2018. See page 2 for details.

The **NPS/THE MINNS FAMILY M & M Ridden Silver Medal Rosette.**

A silver medal rosette is offered by the NPS for the best pure bred ridden pony. If the champion has already qualified it is still entitled to the rosette but the qualification goes to the reserve, qualification goes no lower than first reserve. Owners need not be NPS members to qualify but must become NPS members to enter the **Silver Medal Championship Final** at the **NPS Summer Championship show 2018.**
