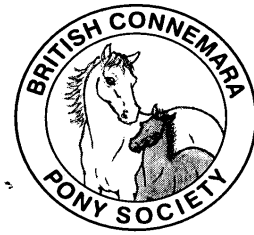

Rules and Regulations

All ponies must be registered by the date of the show in the appropriate section of the BCPS Stud Book or Register, in the Stud Book of an Approved Connemara Society or in the Part-Bred Register where applicable.

A copy of the BCPS Showing Rules is available on the BCPS website, www.britishconnemaras.co.uk. It is the responsibility of Exhibitors to enter ponies correctly in the appropriate class. Neither the organisers of this event nor the BCPS nor any agent or representative thereof accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness or any loss of any kind whether financial or otherwise suffered by any horse, pony, owner, rider, spectator, land building, person, animal or any other property of any type whether caused by negligence, breach of trust, or in any way whatsoever. It is a condition of entry that all exhibitors shall, to the extent allowed by law, indemnify this Show and Officials, Servants and Assistants against all actions, proceeding, claims or otherwise in relation to or arising from his/her entries in this show, and each entry form must be signed as having accepted these conditions.

Objections: Any person wishing to lodge a protest with reference to any person or exhibit shall do so in writing within 30 minutes of the termination of the class, and at the same time shall deposit a sum of £50.00. If on investigation by the organisers the protest is not sustained the deposit shall be forfeited.

Broodmares: Must be free of hereditary diseases. All in-milk mares must be shown with the foal at foot and no foal is to be exhibited under four weeks of age.

Timetable: Exhibitors are asked to note the timetable. The Committee reserves the right to divide, cancel or amalgamate any class where deemed necessary

Refunds: Strictly **No** refund of entry fees.

TO BE RUN UNDER NPS SCOTLAND FINALS (BLAIR CASTLE) RULES 2019, which are on the NPS Scotland website www.npsscotland.co.uk. These rules clarify areas particular to NPS SCOTLAND. We also run to the rules of the National Pony Society and again these can be found on our website.

Exhibitors are deemed to be conversant with these rules

NPS QUALIFIERS: A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony in the M&M In Hand Section. The Sponsor's rosette is also awarded to the pony receiving the qualification. Owners of qualified ponies must become adult Qualifying or Life Members in order to take part in the Final. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in either the NPS/Kilmannan Stud M&M In Hand Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show in Malvern, or at the Championship Show in Scotland. Qualifiers may only compete in one Kilmannan final.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies by NPS Members and non-members and at breed shows ponies can qualify for finals even if their owners are not members. Owners of qualified ponies must become adult qualifying or Life Members to enter the final of the competitions at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 6th -8th August 2019. The highest placed pony, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship – Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the rule book) can wear an white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies are them eligible for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show

Stallions, Mares or Geldings 4 years old and Over

Riders may only ride one pony/horse in each section

To be judged under the rules the National Pony Society 2019

Sect. 1 Height of fences 46cms to 53cms

Sect. 2 Height of fences 53cms to 69cms

Sect. 3 Height of fences 69cms to 84cms

Sect. 4 Height of fences 84cms to 99cms

Ponies/Horses will enter the ring individually and jump a course designed to produce a maximum of 10 jumping efforts, each jumping effort will be marked out of 5. 5 penalties will be incurred for each pole down or run out. Three refusals at any one fence will result in elimination (A maximum of 50 marks will be awarded for a clear round) Fall of pony or rider will result in elimination. There will be no mark awarded for conformation but a mark of 20 will be awarded for overall impression at the completion of each round. In the event of a tie the overall impression will determine the final placings. The three highest placed ponies which have not already qualified within the first six places, will qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship

Riders any age, Riders may only ride one pony in each section

Flatwork Test 30 marks, Jumping 40 marks, Conformation 20 marks Show 10 marks

Min fence height 65cms Max. 76cms Max Fence spread 65cms

Section 2 Registered Connemaras Pure Bred & Part Bred exceeding 138cms but not exceeding 153cms

Min fence height 76cms Max. 90cms Max fence spread 76cms

Riders any age, Riders may only ride one pony in each section

The flat work test is not judged as a pure dressage competition and the judge may stand to the side of the arena to better assess the true suppleness, engagement and acceptance of the aids. Any suitable bridle, a running martingale and protective boots may be worn To immediately follow the flat work, jumping no change of tack is permitted, 4 penalties per knock down or refusal . Fall of the pony/horse or rider or more than three refusals on course will result in elimination. Immediately after completion of the jumping phase ponies/horses will be stripped for the conformation phase.

Following this section marks are totalled in the case of equality the jumping marks take preference followed by Flatwork and finally conformation. The Top 10 will then come forward to complete a go round and gallop individually. They are to be judged on their suitability to go eventing with emphasis on a good ground covering gallop

The three highest placed ponies/horses in each section which has not already qualified, within the first six places goes forward to the final at NPS Summer Championships

Open to pure-bred and part-bred/over height registered Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over.

Class 3 Pure Bred & Part Bred/Over-Height Connemaras Nursery Novice WHP. For ponies/horses in their first year of competing in WHP classes and who have not been placed 1st – 3rd in any novice WHP class as at 1st January in the current year. To be shown in a suitable snaffle bridle

Competitors entered in class 3 may not enter Class 5

Class 4 The NPS/Area25 M & M Novice Working Hunter Pony National Championship
Pure Bred Connemara Stallions, Mares or Geldings 4 years old or over.
To be judged under the rules the National Pony Society 2019

A Pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1st January in the current year, it has done any of the following: i) Won an Open affiliated M&M WHP class ii) Won a class at an M&M WHP (Horse of the Year Show or RIHS) Qualifying round, iii) Qualified for the NPS M&M Novice or Intermediate final at NPS Summer Championship, iv) Qualified for an M&M WHP final at Horse of the Year Show or RIHS in the previous years or in the current year. Riders may only ride one pony in each section. Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit

N.B. Ponies can compete as novices for two consecutive years provided they do not make an entry in the final in the first year

Section 3 Ponies not exceeding 143cms

Fences: Min.65cms Max.75cms Max. Spread 65cms

*The highest placed pony **not** exceeding 133cms qualifies from this section in addition to the highest placed pony exceeding 133cms. At the final ponies will jump in the section relevant to their height*

At the final rider/ponies will jump in the section relevant to their age/height.

The Highest placed Junior rider from this height section to receive a qualifying card for the NPS/Team Murphy M & M Junior WHP National Championship

Section 4 Ponies exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 148cms

Fences: Min.75cms Max.85cms Max. Spread 75cms

At the final rider/ponies will jump in the section relevant to their age/height.

The Highest placed Junior rider from this height section to receive a qualifying card for the NPS/Team Murphy M & M Junior WHP National Championship

Class 5 The NPS/NPS Area 5 M&M Intermediate Working Hunter Pony Championship
Pure Bred Connemara Stallions, Mares or Geldings 5 years old or over.
To be judged under the rules the National Pony Society 2019

Ponies who have qualified for the M&M Working Hunter Pony (Horse of the Year Show/RIHS) Finals before the 1st January in the current year are **not** eligible. Riders may only ride one pony in each class.

Fences: Min 70cms Max. 85cms Max. spread 70cms

*The highest placed pony **not** exceeding 133cms qualifies from this section in addition to the highest placed pony exceeding 133cms. At the final ponies will jump in the section relevant to their height*

The Highest placed Junior rider from this height section to receive a qualifying card for the NPS/Team Murphy M & M Junior WHP National Championship

Section 4 Ponies exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 148cms

Fences: Min 80cms Max. 95cms Max. spread 80cms

*The highest placed pony **not** exceeding 133cms qualifies from this section in addition to the highest placed pony exceeding 133cms. At the final ponies will jump in the section relevant to their height*

The Highest placed Junior rider from this height section to receive a qualifying card for the NPS/Team Murphy M & M Junior WHP National Championship

Class 6 "Section 3 " is a **Qualifier for NPS Scotland/Kingfisher Building Products Mountain & Moorland Open WHP Championship**. The **2** most highly marked ponies from each section, not already qualified, will qualify for the Final which will take place at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Friday 23rd August 2019. **Qualifications to go no lower than 4th place**

Fences: Min.85cms Max. 100cms Max.spread 85cms

The Highest placed Junior rider from this height section to receive a qualifying card for the NPS/Team Murphy M & M Junior WHP National Championship

Class 6 "Section 4" is a **Qualifier for NPS Scotland/Kingfisher Building Products Mountain & Moorland Open WHP Championship**. The **2** most highly marked ponies from each section, not already qualified, will qualify for the Final which will take place at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Friday 23rd August 2019. **Qualifications to go no lower than 4th place**

Pure Bred Championship. 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 3, 4 5 or 6 are to compete for **The Brydie Cup**

Class 7 Working Hunter. Part-Bred and Over-Height Connemara.
Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over

Class 8 Nursery Novice Pure Bred and Part Bred/Over height.

A pony is deemed a Nursery Novice if it is in the first year of competing in ridden classes and has not won any mountain and moorland novice ridden class by the 1st of January in the current year. Ponies will only require to walk and trot together but may canter in their individual show.

Class 9 The NPS/Picton M & M Novice Ridden Qualifier

Pure Bred Stallions, Mares or Geldings 4 years old and over

To be judged under National Pony Society Rules 2019

A pony is **not** eligible to compete if, before the 1st January in the current year it has won an Open affiliated class, mixed M&M Ridden Class, Qualified for the HOYS, Olympia or RIHS open M & M ridden classes. Qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate Ridden Final at the NPS Summer Championships (**N.B. ponies can compete as Novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year**) If a pony qualifies for HOYS or RIHS in its second year it is immediately de-noviced and cannot compete in the Picton Final.

This class is also a qualifier for the **NPS/Dargavel M & M Young Ridden Pony National Championship qualifier** to be judged under **National Pony Society Rules 2019**

This class is also a qualifier for the **NPS/Ryehouse Native Show Team M&M Junior Ridden National Championship qualifier** to be judged under **National Pony Society Rules 2019**. Riders must not have attained their 18th Birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Pure bred qualifier only for NPS Scotland/Kilmannan Stud Novice Ridden Mountain & Moorland Championship.

The 2 highest placed Pure Bred ponies, not already qualified, from class 9 will qualify for the Final which will take place at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Friday 23rd August 2019. Qualification to go no lower than 4th place.

Class 10 The NPS/Peasedown Stud & Jess Talbot M & M Intermediate Ridden National Qualifier

Pure Bred Stallions, Mares or Geldings 5 years old and over.

To be judged under National Pony Society Rules 2019

A pony is **not** eligible to compete if has qualified before the 1st January of the current year for the M&M Ridden Championship Final at Horse of the Year Show/Olympia/RIHS

This class is also a qualifier for the **NPS/Ryehouse Native Show Team M&M Junior Ridden National Championship qualifier** to be judged under **National Pony Society Rules 2019**. Riders must not have attained their 18th Birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 11 The NPS/Ringside Stud M & M Open Ridden National Championship

Pure Bred Stallion, Mares & Geldings 4 years old and over

To be judged under National Pony Society Rules 2019

Pure Bred qualifier only for NPS Scotland/Baileys Open Ridden Mountain & Moorland Championship

The **2 highest** placed ponies not already qualified from Class 11 will qualify for the Final which will take place at Blair Castle International Horse Trails on Friday 23rd August 2019. Qualification to go no lower than 4th place

This is a qualifying class for the **Pure Bred Rosmeen Ridden Championship**. The final to take place at the BCPS Breed Show Saturday 13th July 2019

Pure Bred Ridden Championship 1st and 2nd pure bred prize winners from classes 8 - 11 are eligible for pure bred ridden championship. Champion & Reserve Champion Ponies from Pure Bred Ridden classes to compete for the **Lockinge Hester Knight Memorial Trophy**

Class 12 Open Ridden Part-Bred & Over Height

Part Bred/Over Height Ridden Championship 1st and 2nd part bred/over height prize winners from classes 8 & 12 are eligible for part bred/over height ridden championship

NPS/Standinghat Stud & Show Team M & M Ridden Silver Medal Rosette Championship

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the Best Pure-Bred Ridden Pony in the Show. If the Champion Pony has already qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification goes to the Reserve Champion Pony Qualification to go no lower than first Reserve. The qualifying owner need not be a member of the NPS to qualify at this show. If the owner of the qualifying pony is not an NPS member they must become one before entering the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show August 2019. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in either the NPS/Standinghat Stud & Show Team M&M Ridden Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show in Malvern, or at the Championship Show in Scotland. Qualifiers may only compete in one NPS/Standinghat Stud & Show Team final.
