Riders of stallions must have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January of the current year. All riders while mounted must wear correctly secured current British Standard skull caps/riding hats.

Foals must be over 4 weeks old on the day of the show and must accompany the mare into the ring.

All ponies must be registered by the closing date of entries in the appropriate section of the BCPS Stud Book or Register, in the Stud Book of a recognised Connemara Society or in the Part-Bred Register where applicable.

ENTRIES ARE ACCEPTED ON THE ASSUMPTION THAT EXHIBITORS HAVE READ THESE RULES. The show rules can be found at www.britishconnemaras.co.uk BCPS tab under-about the BCPS. A copy of the show rules may also be obtained from the secretary please enclose a SAE. It is the responsibility of Exhibitors to enter their ponies correctly in the appropriate class.

NPS Qualifying Rounds Breed Show Rules: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective M&M stud books. Part breds are not eligible for M&M classes. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members. The owner of a pony qualifying at a breed show must become an NPS Qualifying/Life member in order to compete at the final. The highest placed pony in each eligible class will qualify for the final. Qualification will pass no lower than 3rd place. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes can be awarded to ponies at breed shows even if their owners are not NPS members but to enter the final they must become an NPS Qualifying/Life member. The highest placed eligible pony from classes 1-4,6-9,11-12 will qualify for the NPS/Pottofields Stud M&M In Hand National Summer Championship. The highest placed pony from classes 1-4,6-9,11-12 wearing a white armband will qualify for the NPS/Sharptor Stud M&M Home-Produced In Hand National Championship. The NPS/Corscaron Essentials Home Produced Ridden National Championship qualifying classes are 50 & 53. All entering as Home Produced must wear white arm bands.

The Price Family Supreme In-Hand held at Stoneleigh Horse Show is a qualifier for Horse of the Year Show, NEC, 5th–9th October 2022. The objective of the competition is to find the supreme light horse or pony in-hand champion of the year, irrespective of breed or type (excluding heavy horses).

The Champion horse or pony from the following classes will be eligible to compete in the Supreme In-Hand Semi Final, provided it has not already won a Supreme In-Hand qualifier in 2022.

The Champion Stallion, The Champion Mare, The Youngstock Champion and The Tam O' Shanter Champion to compete for the Supreme In-Hand Champion.

If the Champion has already qualified for Horse of the Year Show 2022 or is ineligible, then the Reserve Champion may come forward to Stoneleigh, provided it has not already qualified and is eligible. If both Champion and Reserve Champion have already qualified for Horse of the Year Show 2022 or are ineligible then the Semi-Final will not be represented at Stoneleigh. Foal champions and geldings four years old and over are not eligible to compete or eligible to qualify for Horse of the Year Show.

In the event of a horses/pony having been awarded more than one section Championship at this Show, that horse/pony will represent both/all sections and the Semi Final qualification will not pass down to the Reserve Champion in the second and any subsequent sections.

All classes are open to Yearlings, 2 year olds, 3 year olds, Stallions, broodmares and barren mares only. Broodmares must be with foal at foot or a relevant certificate of pregnancy. Mares which have not yet foaled or that have lost their foals are eligible to enter with a relevant certificate of pregnancy for the following year.

There will be no direct entry into the Supreme In-Hand Championship Semi Final, all animals must be a section champion or reserve champion (as applicable).

Judges need not be registered on any society Judges panel but must possess sufficient experience to judge.
