All ponies must be registered by the closing date of entries in the appropriate section of the BCPS Stud Book or Register, in the Stud Book of a recognised Connemara Society or in the Part-Bred Register where applicable.

ENTRIES ARE ACCEPTED ON THE ASSUMPTION THAT EXHIBITORS HAVE READ THESE RULES. The show rules can be found at www.britishconnemaras.co.uk BCPS tab under-about the BCPS. A copy of the show rules may also be obtained from the secretary please enclose a SAE. It is the responsibility of Exhibitors to enter their ponies correctly in the appropriate class

QUALIFIERS AND AFFILIATIONS

NATIONAL PONY SOCIETY (S5.078) Qualifiers for 2022 Summer Championship Show.

NPS QUALIFYING ROUNDS, BREED SHOW RULES: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part breds are not eligible for Mountain & Moorland Classes.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members and at breed shows ponies can qualify for finals even if their owners are not members. Owners of qualified ponies must become adult Qualifying or Life members to enter the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern 2nd - 4th August 2022.

The highest placed pony, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/Corscaron Horse Essentials Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show.

NPS SILVER MEDAL ROSETTE CHAMPIONSHIPS, BREED SHOW RULES: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. At breed shows Silver Medals may be won by non-members. The owner of the qualified pony must become an Adult Qualifying or Life member to enter the final. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette, but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

THE BSPS NEW HORIZON PLASTICS HERITAGE MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIP.

Ponies, Owners and Riders need not be B.S.P.S. Members to compete in the Breed Semi-Final qualifying classes but pony, owner and rider will need to register to compete in the SEMI-FINAL to be held at the B.S.P.S. "Heritage" Championship Show15th &16th October. Classes will be judged under B.S.P.S. rules as per the 2022 B.S.P.S. Rule & Show Handbook. Animals must be the correct height for the breed as laid down in the individual breed standards.

THE TAM O'SHANTER IN-HAND CHAMPIONSHIP

This show is a qualifier for the Tam O'Shanter In-Hand Championship to be held at the BCPS Annual Breed Show 2023. The 3 highest placed ponies in Classes 4,7 and 8 not already qualified will qualify for the finals qualification to go no lower than 6th place.

ROSMEEN RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP

This show is a qualifier for the Rosmeen Ridden Championship to be held at the BCPS Ridden Show 2023. The highest placed 138 pony in class 17 not already qualified (qualification to pass no lower than 3rd place) and the Pure-Bred Ridden Champion if not already qualified will qualify. If the Champion has already qualified then qualification will pass to the Reserve Champion. Exhibitors do not need to be members of the BCPS to qualify for this Championship but will have to pay non-member entry fee in order to compete at the final

NPS DRESSAGE CHAMPIONSHIPS

This show is a qualifier for the NPS Supreme Dressage Championship Final to be held at Bury Equestrian Village, Mill Rd, Slapton, Leighton Buzzard. LU7 9BT on the 21st May 2023. Qualifying rounds are open to competitors from the Uk and elsewhere. All qualifiers will receive a qualification card. The final will run in accordance with the 2022/23 NPS Dressage Rules which will be available to all NPS Members. You must be a fully paid-up Dressage, Qualifying or Life members of the NPS for 2023 in order to compete at the Final.

NCPA

This show is a qualifier for the NCPA Pony of the Year Show 2022. 1st and 2nd Prize-winners in the appropriate classes will qualify. Cards will be handed out in the ring. Visit www.thencpa.co.uk for membership and more information about how to enter.

- i. Won an open affiliated mixed M&M Ridden class
- ii. Qualified for Horse of the Year Show, Olympia or RIHS Open M&M Ridden classes
- iii. Qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate Ridden final at the NPS Summer Championship show (N.B. Ponies can compete as novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year)2020 is excluded when calculating consecutive years
- iv. If a pony qualifies for Horse of the Year Show, Olympia or RIHS in its second year it is immediately de-noviced and cannot compete in the Picton Final. Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit.

Rules for Section 1 A snaffle bridle must be worn. To be judged as a performance class and not as a show class. A rider may ride more than one pony in each class. Previous winner may compete. Rider and Horse/Pony combination not to have competed at any BE80/90 level or at Hoys / RIHS. Height of fences at the final will 75cms.

Ponies enter the ring and perform a show that must include a walk, working trot, canter on both reins, a gallop and finish with a halt of 3 seconds. The show must not exceed 2 minutes. Immediately after the show a **70cms** course of 5/6 jumps will be jumped. Marking as follows (A) Style on the flat 25 marks (B) Jumping style 25 marks, Overall Impression 50 marks. Marks to be deducted (A) Jump knocked down -10, (B) 1st refusal -10, (C) 2nd refusal -20, (D) 3rd refusal = elimination. 1st & 2nd placed ponies to qualify for the final held at the **BCPS Breed Show 2023**

If entered in Section 1 the combination may not enter Section 2

Class 20 - Section 2 Pure/Part Bred & Over Height Connemara Ponies/Horses

Rules for Section 2 A snaffle bridle must be worn. To be judged as a performance class and not as a show class. A rider may ride more than one pony in each class. Previous winner may compete. Height of jumps at the final approx. 80cms.

Ponies enter the ring and perform a show that must include a walk, working and medium trot, canter on both reins and finish with a rein back and a halt of 5 seconds. The show must not exceed 2 minutes. Immediately after the show a **75cms** course of 5/6 jumps will be jumped. Marking as follows (A) style on the flat 25 marks, (B) Jumping style 25 marks Overall impression 50 marks, Marks to be deducted (A) Jump knocked down -10, (B) 1st refusal -10, (C) 2nd refusal -20, (D) 3rd refusal = elimination.1st & 2nd ponies to qualify for the final held at the **BCPS Breed Show 2023**

Class 21 WHP Part-Bred and Over-Height Connemara. Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over

Special rosette to the highest placed novice. Snaffle bridles only for novice horses/ponies. **Please wear arm band if novice.**Maximum height of fences 75cms

PURE BRED WORKING HUNTER PONY CLASSES

No change of rider or saddlery is allowed between phases or during a phase. A correctly fitting hard/skull cap to current BSI standard must be worn and securely fastened. Protective front boots may be used for the jumping and ridden phase only. Bandages and protective pads on pony's feet are not allowed.

The NPS/NAF M&M Novice Working Hunter Pony National Championship (MM-NWHP)

Open to registered pure-bred M&M stallions, mares and geldings, four years old or over. Riders may only ride one pony in each class. Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit.

A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1st January in the current year (**NB: Please note any results from 2020 are exempt**) it has done any of the following:

- i) Won an open affiliated M&M WHP class
- ii) Won a class at an M&M WHP (Horse of the Year Show or RIHS) qualifying round.
- iii) Qualified for the NPS M&M Novice or Intermediate WHP final at the NPS Summer Championship show(NB: Ponies can compete as novices for two consecutive years provided they do not submit an entry in the final in the first year 2020 is excluded when calculating consecutive years.
- iv) Qualified for an M&M WHP final at Horse of the Year Show or RIHS in previous years or in the current year

Class 22 Ponies exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 148cms

Height of Fences 75cms – 85cms max. 75cms spread.

Class 23 Ponies exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms

Height of Fences 65cms -75cms max. 65cms spread.

Class 24 Ponies exceeding 122cms but not exceeding 133cms.

Height of Fences - 85cms - 100cms max.85cms spread

Class 29 – Ponies exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms

Height of Fences - 75cms - 90cms max.75cms spread.
