## **Rules and Regulations**

**All ponies must be registered by the closing date of entries in the appropriate section of the BCPS Stud Book or Register, in the Stud Book of an Approved Connemara Society or in the Part-Bred Register where applicable.**

A copy of the BCPS Showing Rules is available on the BCPS website, [www.britishconnemaras.co.uk](http://www.britishconnemaras.co.uk) It is the responsibility of Exhibitors to enter ponies correctly in the appropriate class. Neither the organisers of this event nor the BCPS nor any agent or representative thereof accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness or any loss of any kind whether financial or otherwise suffered by any horse, pony, owner, rider, spectator, land building, person, animal or any other property of any type whether caused by negligence, breach of trust, or in any way whatsoever.

It is a condition of entry that all exhibitors shall, to the extent allowed by law, indemnify this Show and Officials, Servants and Assistants against all actions, proceeding, claims or otherwise in relation to or arising from his/her entries in this show, and each entry form must be signed as having accepted these conditions.

**Objections:** Any person wishing to lodge a protest with reference to any person or exhibit shall do so in writing within 30 minutes of the termination of the class, and at the same time shall deposit a sum of £50.00. If on investigation by the organisers the protest is not sustained the deposit shall be forfeited.

**Broodmares:** Must be free of hereditary diseases. All in-milk mares must be shown with the foal at foot and no foal is to be exhibited under four weeks of age.

**Timetable:** Exhibitors are asked to note the timetable. The Committee reserves the right to divide, cancel or amalgamate any class where deemed necessary

TO BE RUN UNDER NPS SCOTLAND FINALS (BLAIR CASTLE) RULES 2022 which are on the NPS Scotland website [www.npsscotland.co.uk](http://www.npsscotland.co.uk) These rules clarify areas particular to NPS Scotland. We also run to the Rules of the NPS and again these can be found on our website. Exhibitors are deemed to be conversant with these rules. There are new rules this year so please be vigilant and read them.

This show is a qualifier for **The NPS Scotland/Townhead Pet N Pony In Hand Mountain & Moorland Championship Final, The NPS Scotland Kilmannan Novice Ridden Mountain & Moorland Championship, The NPS Scotland/Baileys Horse Feeds Open Ridden Mountain & Moorland Championship, the NPS Scotland/ Maggie May Junior Open Ridden Championship, and the NPS Scotland/Kingfisher Building Products Mountain & Moorland Open WHP Championship.**

National Pony Society Mountain and Moorland Qualifying Round Breed Show Rules:

These classes are judged under the rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Studbooks. Part-Breds are not eligible for M&M Classes.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members and at breed shows ponies can qualify for finals even if their owners are not members. Owners of qualified ponies must become adult qualifying of Life members to enter the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 2nd-4<sup>th</sup> August 2022.

### **The Tam O'Shanter In Hand Championship**

This show is a qualifier for the Tam O'Shanter In Hand Championship to be held at the annual BCPS Breed Show on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> July 2022 at Moreton Morrell, Warwick, CV35 9BL. The 3 highest placed ponies not already qualified for the finals will qualify, qualification to go no lower than 6<sup>th</sup> place

**This show is a qualifier for the National Pony Society Dressage Finals**

**This show is a qualifier for the Caledonian Showing Championships**

- Class 6** Mare with foal at foot, due to foal or certificate of service. 4 years old and over

***Classes 1 -6 are qualifiers for the NPS/Pottofields Stud In Hand National Championship***

- Class 7** Foals (no entry fee) but please enter on entry form and state age.  
The minimum age for showing foals is four weeks old.

Qualification may go to 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Championship (ie 1<sup>st</sup> Reserve Champion)

### **NPS/Pottofields Stud M&M In Hand Silver Medal Rosette Championship**

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. At Breed Shows Silver Medals may be won by non-members. The owner of the qualified pony must become an Adult Qualifying or Life Member to enter the final. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette, but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

Ponies qualifying in Scotland can go forward to either the Scotland M&M In Hand Silver Medal Rosette Championship final at Blair or the Silver Medal Rosette Championship Final at the NPS Summer Championship show at Malvern. The first qualification awarded will take precedence irrespective of the country when the qualification was won. A pony may qualify for the Silver Medal Final once in a season.

### **Part-Bred/Over- Height In hand section**

- Class 8** Part-bred/Over- Height, 3 years and under.
- Class 9** Part-bred/Over- Height, 4 – 14 years old
- Class 10** Veteran Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 15 years and over

**Class 11      The NPS/THE SIMONS FAMILY/MARBETH STUD Working Pony Training Stakes  
Summer National Championship**

Pure, Part-Bred & Over-Height Connemara Ponies/Horses  
Stallions, Mares or Geldings 4 years old and Over  
Riders may only ride one pony/horse in each section  
To be judged under the rules the National Pony Society 2022

- Sect. 1 Height of fences 46cms to 53cms
- Sect. 2 Height of fences 53cms to 69cms
- Sect. 3 Height of fences 69cms to 84cms
- Sect. 4 Height of fences 84cms to 99cms

Ponies/Horses will enter the ring individually and jump a course designed to produce a maximum of 10 jumping efforts, each jumping effort will be marked out of 5. 5 penalties will be incurred for each pole down or run out. Three refusals at any one fence will result in elimination (A maximum of 50 marks will be awarded for a clear round) Fall of pony or rider will result in elimination. There will be no mark awarded for conformation but a mark of 20 will be awarded for overall impression at the completion of each round. In the event of a tie the overall impression will determine the final placings. The three highest placed ponies which have not already qualified within the first six places, will qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship

**Class 12      Pure Bred & Part Bred/Over-Height Connemaras Nursery Novice WHP.**

For ponies/horses in their first year of competing in WHP classes and who have not been placed 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> in any novice WHP class as at 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year. To be shown in a suitable snaffle bridle

**Competitors entered in class 12 may not enter Class 14/15**

**Class 13      The NPS/NAF M & M Novice Working Hunter Pony National Championship  
Pure Bred Connemara Stallions, Mares or Geldings 4 years old or over.  
To be judged under the rules the National Pony Society 2022**

A Pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year, it has done any of the following: (please note any results from 2020 are exempt): i) Won an Open affiliated M&M WHP class. ii) Qualified for HOYS OR RIHS Open M&M WHP class iii) Qualified for the NPS Novice or Intermediate final at NPS Summer Championship. iv) If a pony qualifies for HOYS or RIHS in its second year it is immediately de-noviced and cannot compete in the Novice WHP Final. Riders may only ride one pony in each section. Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit.

**N.B. Ponies can compete as novices for two consecutive years provided they do not make an entry in the final in the first year.**

**Section 3      Ponies not exceeding 143cms**

Fences: Min.65cms Max.75cms Max. Spread 65cms

The highest placed pony **not** exceeding 133cms qualifies from this section in addition to the highest placed pony exceeding 133cms.

Ponies who have qualified for the M&M Working Hunter Pony (Horse of the Year Show/RIHS) Finals before the 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year are **NOT** eligible. Riders may only ride one pony in each class.

**Section 3   Ponies not exceeding 143cms**

Fences: Min 70cms   Max. 85cms Max. spread 70cms

The highest placed pony **not** exceeding 133cms qualifies from this section in addition to the highest placed pony exceeding 133cms. At the final ponies will jump in the section relevant to their height

The Highest placed Junior rider from this height section to receive a qualifying card for the **NPS/SARAH PLEASE MEMORIAL M & M Junior WHP National Championship**

**Section 4   Ponies exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 148cms**

Fences: Min 80cms   Max. 95cms Max. spread 80cms

The highest placed pony **not** exceeding 133cms qualifies from this section in addition to the highest placed pony exceeding 133cms. At the final ponies will jump in the section relevant to their height

The Highest placed Junior rider from this height section to receive a qualifying card for the **NPS/SARAH PLEASE MEMORIAL M & M Junior WHP National Championship**

**Section 4   Ponies exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 148cms**

The Highest placed Junior rider from this height section to receive a qualifying card for the **NPS/SARAH PLEASE MEMORIAL M & M Junior WHP National Championship**

This show is a qualifier for the **NPS Scotland/Kingfisher Building Products Mountain & Moorland Open WHP Championship**. The 2 highest placed ponies, in each class not already qualified, will qualify for the Final which will take place at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> August 2022. Qualifications to go no lower than 4<sup>th</sup> place

**Pure Bred WHP Championship.**

1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 12, 13, 14 & 15  
are to compete for **The Brydie Cup**

**Class 16   Working Hunter. Part-Bred and Over-Height Connemara.  
Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over**

**Part Bred/Over-Height Championship**

1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 12 & 16  
are eligible for part bred/over height WHP championship.

**Class 17 Nursery Novice Pure Bred and Part Bred/Over height**

A pony is deemed a Nursery Novice if it is in the first year of competing in ridden classes and has not won any mountain and moorland novice ridden class by the 1<sup>st</sup> of January in the current year. Ponies will only require to walk and trot together but may canter in their individual show.

**Class 18 The NPS/Picton M & M Novice Ridden Championship  
Pure Bred Stallions, Mares or Geldings 4 years old and over  
To be judged under National Pony Society Rules 2022**

A pony is **not** eligible to compete if, before the 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year (please note results from 2020 are excluded) if it has won an Open mixed M&M affiliated class qualified for the HOYS, Olympia or RIHS open M & M ridden classes. Qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate Ridden Final at the NPS Summer Championships (**N.B. ponies can compete as Novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year**) If a pony qualifies for HOYS, BSPS Lemeux Final & RIHS in its second year it is immediately de-noviced and cannot compete in the Picton Final.

This class is a qualifier for the **NPS Scotland Kilmannan Novice Ridden Mountain & Moorland Championship**. Ponies **must** wear snaffle bit. The **2** highest placed ponies, not already qualified, in each novice class will qualify for the Final which will take place at Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> August 2022. Qualifications to go no lower than 4<sup>th</sup> place.

This class is also a qualifier for the **NPS/Dargavel M & M Young Ridden Pony National Championship qualifier** to be judged under **National Pony Society Rules 2022**

This class is also a qualifier for the **NPS/ROBINSON M&M Junior Ridden National Championship qualifier** to be judged under **National Pony Society Rules 2022**. Riders must not have attained their 18<sup>th</sup> Birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.

**Class 19 The NPS/Peasedown Stud & Jess Talbot M & M Intermediate Ridden National Qualifier  
Pure Bred Stallions, Mares or Geldings 5 years old and over.  
To be judged under National Pony Society Rules 2022**

A pony is **not** eligible to compete if has qualified before the 1<sup>st</sup> January of the current year for the M&M Ridden Championship Final at Horse of the Year Show/RIHS/BSPS Lemeux Final.

This class is also a qualifier for the **NPS/Dargavel M & M Young Ridden Pony National Championship qualifier** to be judged under **National Pony Society Rules 2022**

This class is also a qualifier for the **NPS/ROBINSON M&M Junior Ridden National Championship qualifier** to be judged under **National Pony Society Rules 2022**. Riders must not have attained their 18<sup>th</sup> Birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.

**Class 20 The NPS/Ringside Stud M & M Open Ridden National Championship  
Pure Bred Stallion, Mares & Geldings 4 years old and over  
To be judged under National Pony Society Rules 2022**

This is a qualifying class for the **Pure Bred Rosmeen Ridden Championship**. The final to take place at the BCPS Breed Show 2022.

This show is a qualifier for the **NPS Scotland/Baileys Horse Feeds Open Ridden Mountain & Moorland Championship**. The **2** highest placed ponies, not already qualified, will qualify for the Final which will take place at Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> August 2022. Qualifications to go no lower than 4<sup>th</sup> place.

**NPS Scotland/Maggie May Junior Open Ridden Championship**. A qualifier will be awarded to the highest placed Junior within the Open Ridden Class provided that the pony is a mare or gelding (No Stallions). The Junior must be the correct age for the pony they are riding (Large Breeds – under 18 years on 1st January in the current year). The Highest placed Junior Ridden Pony, in the Open Ridden Class not already qualified, will qualify for the Final which will take place at The Blair Castle International Horse Trials on 26th August 2022. Qualifications to go no lower than 4th place.



## **Pure Bred Ridden Championship**

1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> pure bred prize winners from classes 17 - 20 are eligible for pure bred ridden championship. Champion & Reserve Champion Ponies from Pure Bred Ridden classes to compete for the **Lockinge Hester Knight Memorial Trophy**

### **NPS/ THE NICHOLLS FAMILY M & M Ridden Silver Medal Rosette Championship**

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the Best Pure-Bred Ridden Pony in the Show. If the Champion Pony has already qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification goes to the Reserve Champion Pony Qualification to go no lower than first Reserve. The qualifying owner need not be a member of the NPS to qualify at this show. If the owner of the qualifying pony is not an NPS member they must become one before entering the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show August 2022. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in either the NPS M&M Ridden Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show in Malvern. Qualifiers may only compete in one final.
